What part stands out the most to you personally?

For you, what is the hardest part of loving people?

Talk about a situation where you were stretched in the area of loving a person to where Christ wanted them to be? (No names please)

At work, play, church, shopping and wherever else you go, what does loving someone to where Christ wants them to be look like?

Read 1Corinthians 9:19-23 How do we apply this to life?

In what ways does our church mission statement conflict with the way the world operates?
