

We have been going through the Lord's prayer. This week we talked about Matthew 6:11. "Give us this day our daily bread" is the fourth of the seven petitions in the Lord's prayer (the first three address God, the second four are prayers related to our needs and concerns). We need God in all areas of our life (physical, spiritual and mental), and this is a daily need. We need to come back to God regularly, each day- indeed, many times each day and many ways, for we can quickly become independent and self-seeking. Jesus reiterates this daily dependency when he exhorts us to not "worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself"

In your life, what area do you struggle with the most with asking God for your daily bread? Take some time and ask God to show you why there is such a struggle in this area.

Have there been times you have asked God for something for yourself or someone else and it did not turn out as you had hoped it would? Take some time and talk with God about this. Then find someone you can talk about this with.

In the upcoming week, take time to give thanks for the physical, spiritual and mental needs He has met for you.
