

Read 1 Peter 3:1-6. Peter referred to women in verse 5 as "holy women." Holy women are called women who hoped in God - who feared God.

So, what does a God-fearing woman look like? Read Proverbs 31:10-31.

Read Proverbs 31:30.

What does it mean to "fear the Lord?" Why is it so important that we praise a woman who fears the Lord? How can you tell if a woman fears the Lord? What does it look like in action?

What do the following Psalms have to say about fearing the Lord? Psalm 25:14; 31:19; 33:18; 34:7; 103: 11; 103:13; 145: 19; and 147:11.

Can you think of a woman in your life who has exemplified faith, hope, and fear of the Lord? Does she know she's been an encouragement/mentor in your life?

This week and here on out, praise the God-fearing women in your life. You will strengthen her heart in God (Proverbs 31:28), honor the Lord (1 Corinthians 1:31), and add great joy to your own life (Psalm 37:4).
